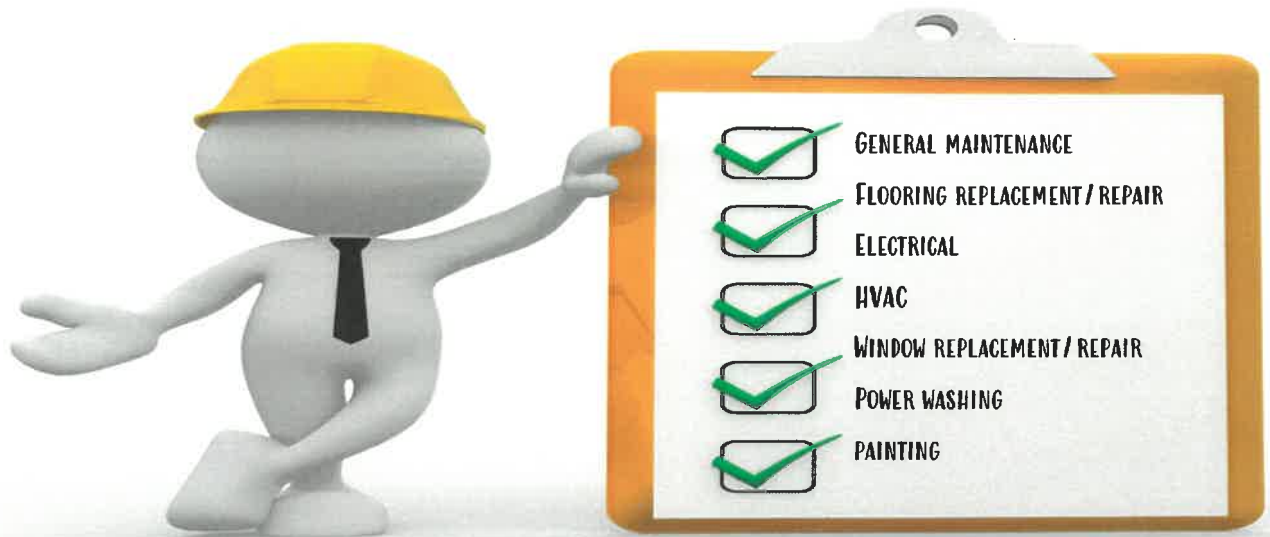

Crab-Stuffed Avocados



Ingredients:

- 1/2 C Canola Mayonnaise
- 1/4 C Fresh Lemon Juice
- 3 TBSP Chopped Fresh Tarragon
- 1/2 TSP Black Pepper
- 12 OZ Lump Crabmeat, shell pieces removed
- Cooking Spray
- 2 Ripe Avocados, Halved & Pitted

Directions:

- Step 1: Combine mayo, lemon juice, tarragon, and black pepper in a bowl; gently fold in crab
- Step 2: Heat a large cast iron skillet over medium-high heat. Coat pan with cooking spray. Place avocado halves, cut sides down, in pan.; cook 2 minutes or until lightly browned.
- Step 3: Place avocados halves, cut sides down, on a cutting board; cut a very small (1/16-inch) slice from the bottom of each half so that it stands flat. Turn over; spoon about 1/2 cup crab mixture into each avocado half.

Sweet Tea Sangria

Ingredients:

- 6 C. Sweet Tea
- 1 Bottle White Wine
- 1 PT. Berries
- Sliced Peaches
- Fresh Mint

Directions:

1. Fill a pitcher with 6 cups of sweet tea and a bottle of white wine.
2. Add berries and peaches
3. Let chill for a few hours (of even better, overnight!)
4. Garnish with fresh mint (optional). For extra presentation points, serve in Mason jars with tea bags tied around the lid with twine.

RECYCLING TIPS



Recyclable materials may be taken to one of the City's five Brush Sites located throughout the city. Just separate and deposit the materials into labeled bins. Accepted materials can be found at stpete.org/recycling.

St. Petersburg brush sites do not accept plastic trash or grocery bags, plastic dry cleaning or newspaper bags, plastic wrappers from water bottles, toilet paper, or paper towel packaging, flimsy plastic packaging or Styrofoam. These items should be thrown away in the trash.

There is no need to separate items for the City's recycling program. Items that may be recycled include

- ⇒ Glass containers (all colors)
- ⇒ Aluminum & steel cans, steel jar lids
- ⇒ Most plastics with numbered triangles #1-7—see below for plastics restrictions and guidelines
- ⇒ Newspapers , magazines, mail, shopping ads, windows envelopes
- ⇒ Mixed paper/cardboard

Pet Owner Reminders:

- Pets are not allow in the common areas, such as the Clubhouse, pool area or any other location where people congregate. Should a pet be found running free, it will be held for pick up by Animal Control
- Any pet litter must be removed from the home space by the pet owner daily and deposited in a plastic garbage bag for disposal and not put at any location that could endanger the health of any persons. ***Do not dump animal waste in the common area trash cans.***
- Pets are not allowed to run free. When outside, they must be on a leash. Pets shall not be tied up outside the mobile home and left unattended. "Beware of Dog" signs are not permitted. Pets that bite, constantly bark or are vicious or unruly pets or those about which justifiable written complaints are received are not allowed to remain in the Community.

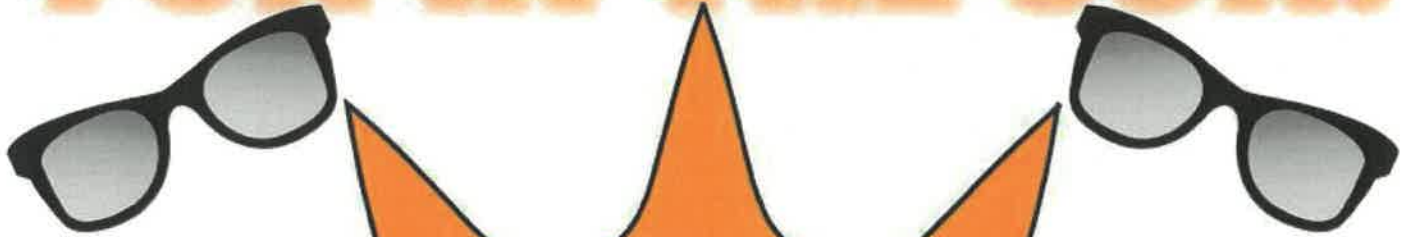
